Leading Across Borders: Developing Global Leadership Skills for an Interconnected World is a 3-credit Honors College course designed to cultivate globally competent, reflective, and adaptable leaders. The course provides training in interpersonal and global leadership skills while offering insights into the habits, mindsets, and skills associated with success and quality of life across cultures.

Through a series of in-person and online lectures, group discussions, and experiential learning activities in Italy, students develop their cultural intelligence, flexibility, and self-awareness; all skills needed to navigate unfamiliar and complex global environments. Emphasis is placed on theory of Cultural Intelligence and other executive coaching tools, ethical engagement, and personal growth.
