Walk the cobbled streets of Edinburgh, roam the Scottish Highlands, stand atop the cliffs in the Ring of Kerry, visit the historic town of Cork, and wander through Dublin's literary past.

This course combines classroom learning with immersive travel, giving you the chance to experience castles, ancient sites, and breathtaking landscapes that inspired some of the world's most famous myths.

- Students will be evaluated based on questionnaire responses, GPA, Title IX/Student Conduct standing, previous travel experience, connection to the course and/or location and the student's life/career goals. Preference will be given to students traveling abroad for the first time.
- Selected students will be notified by Friday, October 31, 2025. Alternates will also be notified on this date.
- Selected students must commit to the Study & Travel program by November 10, 2025 at 11:59 p.m.
